Basic Job Description:

Stationed in Ireland and responsible for global supply chain of intermediates and finished good products including supply planning and supporting distribution of products for global biopharma with company operations in the US, Vienna and Ireland. Manages and implements the planning, purchasing, and support distribution processes. Provides leadership and strategic direction through management of planning activities, processes, and data/information and systems. Identify and implement continuous improvement initiatives that optimize inventory turns, service levels, maximize profitability, and support dynamic changes in market conditions.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Develop, implement, and execute strategic supply chain processes in support of supply chain and business objectives
- Responsible for managing planners and buyers who create and achieve production/purchase plans in support of goals & objectives. (Demand/Supply Optimization in accordance with business rules)
- Responsible for inventory management, ordering API and starting materials through finished products
- Responsible for customs/tariff management in conjunction with inter-country shipments
- Meets with suppliers and other third-party vendors to discuss issues, performance, and future strategies.
- Responsible to coordinate and support S&OP Review meetings identify business critical issues and facilitate discussion and decision making in support of goals & objectives
- Accountable for optimizing inventory turns in support of efficient product lifecycle management
- Accountable for maximizing service levels, in conjunction with inventory goals, through distribution requirement planning and deployments
- Lead and facilitate cross-functional and cross-cultural teams in support of strategic initiatives both within the supply chain organization and across the business
- Responsible to provide management with inventory projections and proactively identifies service level issues with vendors, CMO or other third party suppliers
- Works with order management, sales & marketing, product managers, manufacturing, suppliers, distribution centers and third-party logistics provider in support of business objectives
